Batavia Rod & Gun Club Safety Rules

Safety is the top priority of our club. As such the following mandatory safety rules apply to all shooters and bystanders while on the course and in the clubhouse. It is expected that all shooters, whether a member of our club or not, assist in the enforcement of these rules for everyone's safety.

- Eye and hearing protection is required at all times while on the course.
- Gun breeches are to remain open at all times when not in the shooting box.
- Ammunition shall only be loaded into gun chambers while in the shooting box. No more than 2 shells may be loaded.
- Only low brass target loads intended for Sporting Clays, Trap,
 Skeet or other clay target disciplines are to be used.
- The largest shot size that may be used is 7 1/2
- All targets shall be shot from the designated shooting box and from no other location.
- All shooters and bystanders shall follow the designated course path(s) to each shooting station. Cutting through is prohibited.
- Guns shall not be raised, shouldered or pointed while in the clubhouse. It is recommended that you leave your guns in your vehicle until you are ready to shoot.

Remember, safety is everyone's responsibility. If you do not follow all safety rules or abide by any safety instructions given, Batavia Rod & Gun reserves the right to dismiss you from club property at any time.
